The original of this document was prepared from the transcripts of interviews recorded with various Ewelme residents and others with Ewelme connections. The recordings took place initially over a period of five years, starting in 1995, and were carried out by members of the 20th Century Ewelme Millennium Project. Others were added after 2000.

The main subjects are arranged alphabetically in order to aid research. These contain the basic information. More general information is recorded on the audio tapes themselves and on the file named 'Interviews' which contain the whole recorded interview.

Due to the lapse of time, in some instances recollections of individuals may be at variance with others. No attempt has been made to standardise the answers or memories.

Much of the material collected through the interviews was incorporated into the book *Glimpses of an Oxfordshire Village*.

This version of the Interviews prepared for the Ewelme History Web Site are grouped by subject with links. Some of the interviewees are still living and so all the memories have been anonymised to protect the identity and privacy of the interviewee. Thus some of the context of the memories has been lost in this version but they still present a valuable historical resource and give a flavour of life in Ewelme in times past.
